These customers have stated to BGE that there have been individuals going door to door asking to see BGE bills and that these individuals were wearing green shirts with a BGE logo. In addition, BGE has received several calls from our customers stating that they have received calls from individuals that are representing themselves as BGE.

BGE would like to remind all parties that under the MD Consumer Protection Regulations, suppliers may not engage in a marketing or trade practice that is unfair, false, misleading, or deceptive. This includes the use of BGE's logo in any matter without BGE's express written permission. Violating these regulations can have serious ramifications for a supplier. Moreover, such practices can seriously damage the Maryland competitive environment. BGE feels, as we are sure that you do, that well informed customers that are treated honestly will result in a competitive market that will benefit everyone.
